**NOTICE FOR SETTLEMENT OF RETAIL VEND OF FOREIGN LIQUOR SHOPS BY
WAY OF SELECTION METHOD.**

It is hereby notified for general information that licenses are proposed to be offered for retail vend of **Foreign Liquor shops** within the Dhalai District through selection method for the financial year 2011-12 and for the financial year 2012-13 under the provisions of Rule 29A read with Rule 22 of the Tripura Excise Rules, 1990.

2. Intending bidders shall send their bids addressed to the Collector of Excise, Dhalai District in plain paper in sealed cover. The bids shall be sent by the bidders through registered post so as to reach the office of the undersigned within **19 (nineteen) days** from the date of publication of this notification in an extra ordinary issue of Tripura Gazette. The registered sealed cover should indicate the following heading **“notice for settlement of retail vend of foreign liquor shops by way of selection method, No..... & dated....”**.

3. The applicant quoting the bid shall submit alongwith the following documents:-

- i) Attested copy of Citizenship Certificate/Permanent Residential Certificate/PAN Card of the applicant.
- ii) A statement of immovable property alongwith supporting document(s) and current Bank balance mentioning name of Bank and Account No. to prove his/her financial ability to carry on the business. A certificate from the concerned Bank Manager about the present bank balance of the bidder mentioning the account No. should also be given.
- iii) The details of the location & description of the building (owned or hired) including all required document(s) of the building including land particulars & in case of hired building a no objection certificate from the owner of the building alongwith supporting document(s).
- iv) Income Tax, Sales Tax and Professional Tax Clearance Certificate.
- v) The applicant shall declare that he/ she has never been convicted by a criminal court for committing any offence.
- vi) Applicant declare that he /she shall comply with the provisions of Tripura Excise Act, 1987 and Rules, order, notification, Executive instruction etc. Issued there under.
- vii) In case of existing licensee, applicant shall declare that he/she is former licensee but in not any arrears to the Government and his/her conduct has not been found to be unsatisfactory and that he/she never been found guilty of any breach of conditions of license.
- viii) Applicant shall enclose a security deposit of 50% of the quoted bid value being security deposit against the period mentioned in the notice inviting selection in favour of Collector of Excise of the concerned District in the form of deposit-at- call either from State Bank of India or any Nationalized Bank or TGB or TSCB.

4. If any of the listed documents are found missing / wanting for the bid will be summarily rejected and if any bidder conceals any of material fact and if subsequently it is proved that the bidder concealed the relevant facts, the license will be cancelled automatically by the licensing authority.

The retail Foreign Liquor shops will be settled through selection in and around existing sites/ locations under the provision of Rule 29A of the Tripura Excise Rules 1990 for the financial year 2011-12 and for the financial year 2012-13 subject to fulfillment of terms and condition as required under the Tripura Excise Act, 1987 and Rules made there under.

6. The successful applicant shall have to deposit balance amount of quoted bid value before issue of license, if fails to deposit the same then 50% of the bid money submitted alongwith selection being security deposit would be forfeited by the selection authority.

7. The licensee shall be required to obtain necessary liquor permit from the Collector of Excise after fulfilling the requirements prescribed in the Tripura Excise Act, 1987 and Rules made there under.

8. The selection will be opened in the office of the Collector of Excise, Dhalai District, at **11.30am on 22/09/2011** when the interested applicants may remain present to observe the proceeding.

9. The Collector of Excise, Dhalai District reserves the right to accept or cancel any bid including the highest one without assigning any reason thereof.
